

A Message From Ed Stone, Chairman


Welcome to the 12th edition of the Stone Family Adoption Assistance Fund annual newsletter. As in prior years we have many new stories to tell you about how your generosity has helped to change the lives of deserving adoptive children and families. Although it was still a difficult year due to the Covid pandemic, we assisted a record number of families with their adoption needs. As the reputation of our fund spreads, we still have a backlog of families with requests for aid. My hope is that you will continue to support us in changing the lives of these adoptive families.

In Andrew's memory, The Stone Family Adoption Assistance Fund provided grants to 14 families this year. In addition to awarding grants to pay for adoption

fees and home studies, we helped families with

various needs such as neurofeedback therapy, fetal alcohol spectrum disorder, educational software and learning tools, economic hardship with special needs children and a chairlift for a handicapped child. We continue to be a sponsor of Wonderfund Adoption Events where children in the foster care system can be introduced to parents looking to adopt. We have seen much success from these events and have awarded grants to families that have adopted children they were introduced to at these events.

Over the past six years the success of our Annual Appeal has encouraged us to continue it. This is our only fundraising event and we fund all our assistance to adoptive families through this effort. Dear Ed & Elaine:

I cannot thank you, and the members of the Board of the Stone Family Adoption Assistance Fund, enough for the generous grant to assist with the adoption of my beautiful son Harry. I started the adoption journey to adopt a child from China. But when the coronavirus hit, I did not want to wait until the pandemic was over to adopt a child. I felt a sense of urgency because of my age and



because of the fact that there was so much uncertainty surrounding travel to

China and the future of adoptions from this country. I changed my adoption plan and decided to adopt a newborn in the U.S.

Because I switched from an international adoption to domestic, the cost virtually doubled. The grant funding you have so generously given me will help pay for the adoption and greatly lighten the financial burden it's had on me. Being able to eliminate the adoption debt sooner is a huge help and I am so incredibly grateful to you both and to your foundation.

On March 18, 2021, I received a call from my adoption agency that there was a baby boy born 7 weeks early in Florida. I met Harry when he was 9 days old, and spent a week with him before he was released from the NICU. We were able to return to Massachusetts on April 12th, and I'm so happy and blessed to be home with my beautiful baby boy.

Someday, I will tell Harry about the adoption journey that began with a plan to go to China, and ended very happily in a NICU in Florida. I will tell Harry about your wonderful foundation, your beautiful son Andrew and the joy you brought to me, our family and so many families in honor of your son. Many thanks for all you and your foundation have done for Harry and me, and for all you do to help families.
